Alaska Works Partnership will provide training for 70 participants from rural communities for employment on ANTHC construction projects. AWP will conduct four training events, offering courses in plumbing and carpentry for 70 participants from rural communities.

Planning and recruitment activities were conducted for the training events, which included selection of instructors and a training location, procurement of tools and materials, and securing transportation and housing.

Plumbing Level I Training: (January 21-February 2, 2008) Five (5) participants attended training from Port Lions, Larson Bay, Klukwan, and Hoonah. Students received certificates for OSHA 10 and First Aid/CPR in addition to their completion certificates.

Plumbing Level I and Carpentry Level I Training: (March 24-April 4, 2008) *St. Mary's Training Center, Anchorage, AK.* Eighteen (18) trainees attended from Kwigilligok and Akiak. Students received OSHA 10 certificates, and the carpentry students received the HILTI Powder Actuated Tools certificate.
