





A. INTRODUCTION

Throughout this Amendment these entities are referred to as follows:

City of Hughes	=	City
Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium	=	ANTHC
Financial Assistance Sub-Award	=	FSA
Denali Commission	=	Commission

On Sept. 25, 2002, ANTHC and the City of Hughes executed an FSA authorized by the Denali Commission to renovate the city's existing washeteria. The project was funded with \$64,841, via Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 0068-DC-2002-I21, Amendment No. 1, dated June 2002.

On Jan. 30, 2004, ANTHC and the City of Hughes executed an Amendment No. 1 to the FSA to add \$85,159 to renovate washeteria bathrooms and showers. The additional funds were via Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 0068-DC-2002-I21, Amendment No. 3, dated April 2003.

B. REVISION OF PROJECT FUNDING

This Amendment adds \$128,500 to cover cost overruns due to increased material costs. The additional funds are provided via Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 272-07, dated February 2007.

Project funding therefore totals \$278,500.
