A. INTRODUCTION

Throughout this Amendment these entities are referred to as follows:

City of Ruby	=	City
Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium	=	ANTHC
Cooperative Project Agreement	=	CPA
Denali Commission	=	Commission

On Aug. 12, 2005, ANTHC and the City of Ruby executed a CPA authorized by the Denali Commission to complete the construction and equipping of a washeteria; the construction/equipping phase began under ANTHC Project Nos. AN 01-Q40, AN 04-CE5 and AN 04-N75.

The project was funded with \$662,000, via Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 182-05, dated July 2005.

B. REVISION OF PROJECT FUNDING

This Amendment adds \$271,000 to cover increases in the following costs:

- equipment, fuel and materials
- constructing a road to the gravel source
- additional site work

The additional funds are provided via Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 272-07, dated February 2007.

Project funding therefore totals \$933,000.
