Re: Washeteria Repair and Renovation - Suspension of Award Offer

Dear Ms Leswick:

On November 8, 2004 we received the signed documents for the Washeteria Repair and Renovation award. In the time since the award was originally mailed to Carl Jerue, Jr. on August 13, 2004 there have been a number of discussions with Jim Patterson of the ADEC Village Safe Water (VSW). Your Tribal Administrator and Mr. Patterson were aware that the award was conditional on VSW providing engineering oversight on the project. VSW intended to incorporate the oversight service into a \$75,000 contract with a private sector firm to study the feasibility of installing water and sewer infrastructure for the Anvik community and reviewing engineering questions regarding the washeteria. Our most current information is that the VSW engineering contracts are still pending. This is an essential condition of the award.

The August 13 award of \$125,000 for repairs had an additional condition that the Tribal Council would provide the project \$53,822 in cash and in-kind services. We see this as a significant commitment, essential to the success of the project. For that reason (and the resolution of the engineering questions), we will suspend the award until Tribal elections take place and a resolution of support and other documents can be generated by the new leadership.

We look forward to your contacting us when you are ready to proceed. At that time, we would be pleased to work with our state partner VSW to assist the community in getting the desired renovations and repairs.
