

A. INTRODUCTION

On November 8, 2002, ANTHC and the Village of Takotna executed an FSA authorized by the Denali Commission to complete design studies and construction planning for a new health clinic in Takotna, Alaska. No construction will be performed under this project phase.

The project was funded by Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 0071-DC-2002-I24, dated April 2002.

B. REVISION OF PROJECT BUDGET

This project was originally awarded \$66,800. This Amendment adds \$34,356 of Commission funding for a total award of \$101,156.


