INTRODUCTION

A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) issued by the Denali Commission in March 2001 preceded the current Financial Assistance Award and defines, in detail, the ANTHC roles and responsibilities in managing the development of Alaska Rural Primary Health Care Facilities. Those duties defined in part C pages 4 and 5 of the MOU have been actively developed and worked on by ANTHC and our consultants during the quarter ending June 30, 2001.

Since the March 20, 2001 issuance of the subject Financial Assistance Award ANTHC has developed and implemented a system for surveying Primary Health Care Facilities in 120 rural Alaskan communities. The list of communities was initially divided according to priorities of perceived need and numbered sequentially. Communities in groups 1 and 2 were contacted with Letters of Agreement identifying ANTHC as the commission's agent allowing for code and condition surveys of existing clinics and/or tribal participation in project planning efforts.
