***Award Conditions to the Financial Assistance Award  
Between the Denali Commission and Alaska Energy Authority  
For the Middle Kuskokwim Regional Energy Project  
Award No. 0148-DC-2005, Amendment 1  
June 2005***

All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

***1. Scope of Work***

There are no changes to the award conditions or time. Full construction project funding is aggregated onto a single award for consistency and visibility of the true costs of construction of this important regional project. The source of a portion of funding is revised by this amendment. This scope of work includes an increase in funding of \$900,000 to this award. The Middle Kuskokwim Regional Energy Project funding remains funded at \$12,500,000.

***2. Award Performance Period***

The Award performance period remains December 1, 2004 through June 30, 2006. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award. Due to the nature of this funding completion award, costs incurred prior to December 1, 2004 for elements which have been carried forward from a previous award are allowable under this award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
