All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

1. *Award Performance Period*

The Commission agrees to the extension of the award performance period requested in letters from Village Safe Water dated April 30, 2004 and June 14, 2004. The award performance period is extended until June 30, 2006. Final report and close-out are due September 30, 2006.

This is in recognition of Napaskiak's intent to complete the secondary water treatment plant in conjunction with new Washeteria construction. This amendment recognizes the delays encountered due to the need for a water treatment pilot study to address the extremely high iron/manganese content of the water; the extensive additional design requirements for treating the water; the need to wait for winter to install piles (winter of 2002 and 2003); and the desire by the community to construct a bridge across a slough to accommodate boardwalk access to the lagoon, under design and construction in another (non-Denali Commission) grant.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award.
