All changes to the award conditions are noted below

1. Scope of Work

The following changes are made to the scope of work:

Ambler Washeteria project AN02-G39

The ANTHC is responsible for the construction and equipping of a washeteria facility consistent with the design presented to the Denali Commission December 6, 2005.

The existing Ambler city office building will be remodeled to house the washeteria facility. Changes include: 736 square feet of the first floor of the building plus an addition of 288 square feet and 64 square feet for an arctic entry. Interior equipment will include clothes washers, dryers, restrooms, and showers. The approved design specifically does not include a sauna, hot tub or whirlpool. Mechanical equipment and utilities improvements are those necessary to support operation of the washeteria. Any substantial variance from the submitted design requires pre-approval from the Commission. It is acknowledged that discovery during remodeling may affect the completion date and require an extension.

2. Award Performance Period

The amended Award performance period is April 1, 2002 through December 31, 2006. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award.
