***Award Conditions to the Financial Assistance Award
Between the Denali Commission and
The Four Dam Pool Power Agency
For the Swan Lake – Lake Tye Intertie Continuation
Award No. 0130-DC-2004-117, Amendment 4
January 2006***

All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

1. Scope of Work

Re-prioritize work to be carried out from the partial construction activities previously authorized (pile-caps, foundation installation and further clearing) to different infrastructure components for the Swan Lake—Lake Tye Intertie which can be fully completed independent of future funding, and which will produce, immediate and on-going benefits to the inter-tied systems, even before the intertie is fully functional. The three new tasks to be completed are:

- a. Replace frequency governors on Lake Tye power project to reduce system instabilities and outages in Petersburg and Wrangell,
- b. Convert analog Power-line carrier (PLC) telecommunication system to the Lake Tye Hydroelectric power project to digital microwave system to prepare for the inter-tied system and improve system responsiveness, and
- c. Conduct analysis of Swan-Tye Intertie transmission line operations under various scenarios of wet, dry and normal-year precipitation effects on the Swan Lake and Tye Lake reservoirs, coupled with expected load growth at both Petersburg/Wrangell and Ketchikan, and determine probable power flows for economic, operational and maintenance planning for the first 30 years of operational life of the intertie.

Any of this work which cannot be funded within the remaining \$2,889,544 of Denali Commission funding previously awarded, will be funded by the Four Dam Pool Power Agency, and the additional funds will be considered as match or contributed funds to the project. This amendment does not provide any additional funding.

2. Award Performance Period

The Award performance period remains May 1, 2004 through December 31, 2006. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
