All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

1. Award Performance Period

The Award performance period is extended by this amendment. The amended Award performance period is January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2006. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award.

2. Direct and Indirect Costs

The original award issued March 2004, incorrectly stated that the cost principles 48 CFR 31.2, Contracts with Commercial Organizations are applicable to this Award. Because Chugach Electric Association Inc., is a nonprofit electrical cooperative, the proper citation is OMB Circular A-122, Cost Principles for Nonprofit Organizations. This amendment corrects the award conditions to the original Financial Assistance Award. The correction is also reflected on the Financial Assistance Award coversheet to this amendment. The corrected statement for section 4 is as follows:

The Cost Principles of OMB Circular A-122, Cost Principles for Nonprofit Organizations, are applicable to this Award. Indirect costs are not allowable under this Award. Please refer to the cost principles regulations for specific details on other allowable charges under this Award.
