

Purpose of this Agreement: This Agreement documents the intent of the parties for final design review and construction management project funding.

Authority: This Agreement is entered into between the undersigned parties pursuant to allocation of funds to Denali Commission as defined in SAFETEA-LU. Denali Commission December 14, 2006 Transportation Advisory Committee project selection process meeting approval established the intent of the Denali Commission to allocate funds to the Corps of Engineers for the construction phase of the Pelican harbor rehabilitation project. The approved fund total is \$100,000.

Funds allocated for this project are for final engineering and construction for harbor rehabilitation at Pelican, Alaska. The project will comply with federal requirements including the compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Amendments to the scope of this project agreement may be required dependent upon review of future NEPA document and environmental permit actions. Modifications to this agreement will be approved by an amended agreement signed by all parties.

Project Background: Pelican is located in Southeast Alaska on Chichagof Island in Lisianski Inlet. The small boat harbor was constructed in 1957 by the Corps of Engineers.

Planning and Coordination: Efforts to prepare final design documents for and to construct harbor improvements will need input from the users, including the harbormaster and city manager.

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Project Scope: The purpose of the project is to provide harbor rehabilitation final design and construction for Pelican. The exact needs are not known. The project will include a review of existing NEPA documentation and permits associated with the project, including a real estate plan confirming that needed easements are acquired. Estimated acquisition costs will be reviewed. The need for additional survey or a geotechnical investigation will be determined.

Project Purpose and Benefits: This is a safety project that will replace deteriorated floats and associated facilities. It will also expand facilities, which will provide new economic savings. The harbor will operate more efficiently, including transfer of local cargo. It will improve the quality of life for residents and visitors by providing a safe and efficient transportation link between the water and the community.

Proposed Work FY 2007 and FY 2008

Final Engineering: Starting as early as August 2007 obtain existing design plans, including NEPA, permit and Right-of-Way documentation to conduct a project review and update. Meet with the community to confirm project scope and purpose.

Construction: Starting in early 2008, prepare bid documents advertising and execute contractor selection if bids are affordable. During construction, perform construction management tasks associated with the project, including cost accounting and construction inspection.

Denali Commission funds, in concert with other funding sources, will be used to execute final design and construction. Denali Commission funds in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 will be used for the following tasks.

Final Design Engineering	\$35,000
Construction	\$65,000

Quarterly reports will be filed with the Denali Commission to inform all parties on how project design and construction are progressing.

Corps will ensure a quality product. Corps's designated project contact is the Project Manager.

Project documents will be available for public review and use for all interested parties.

Funding: \$100,000 of Denali Commission funds will be allocated to perform the work described in this agreement.

Amendments to the Project Agreement: This Project Agreement may be modified by mutual agreement of the affected parties.
