All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

***1. Scope of Work***

This amendment does not include changes to the scope of work, but confirms present priorities for remaining funding.

**General Scope of work for this project is:** Construct 57-mile transmission line in SE Alaska from the Swan Lake hydroelectric plant at the head of Carroll Inlet on Revillagigedo Island to the Tyee Lake Hydroelectric Plant on the Bradfield Canal.

Denali Commission funding was not expected nor intended to be adequate to complete this project. During the development of this project and, while awaiting authorization of completion funding from other sources (primarily the State of Alaska, \$46.2 million in 2007), the Commission and Four Dam Pool Power Agency have worked to prioritize the interim work that could be completed to benefit the inter-tied systems even before the intertie was completed.

**This amendment** extends the award period through the 2008 summer construction period, and confirms the final priority of interim work is to complete Right-of-Way clearing, danger tree removal and procurement of the tower bases. This will complete the Denali Commission funded elements of work on the Swan Lake-Lake Tyee Intertie: final reports will be filed and this award will be closed when these elements are completed.

***2. Award Performance Period***

The amended Award performance period is May 1, 2004 to August 31, 2008. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
