**General Scope of work for this project is:** Construct 57-mile transmission line in SE Alaska from the Swan Lake hydroelectric plant at the head of Carroll Inlet on Revillagigedo Island to the Tye Lake Hydroelectric Plant on the Bradfield Canal.

All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

***1. Scope of Work—Activities to be undertaken with the amendment 2 funding include the following:***

A reroute of the line requires additional clearing to complete, plus there is some general cleanup required in constructing helipads and removing danger trees: Klam Creek Reroute - \$1,600,000. Approximately 30% of the foundation pile caps have been paid for and the rest are needed for the 2005 construction season: Pile Caps - \$718,000. Completion of the foundations requires sleeve connectors to join pile caps to micropiles: Connectors - \$350,000. Approximately 60% of the micropile installations were completed in 2004; installation of remaining micropile foundations requires \$5,700,000 plus monies for environmental monitoring, inspection, helicopter support and contractor mobilization: for the Denali contribution, estimate \$346,000 of the total funds required in 2005.

***2. Award Performance Period***

The award performance period is extended to December 31, 2006. This is the period during which Financial Assistance Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
