1. Scope of Work

STAR, Inc.

This award creates a new project, project number 06-4-C-5032, for Standing Together Against Rape (STAR, Inc.). A total of \$616,667 will be deducted from the Domestic Violence (DV) Pool Project 196-05-A and added to project 06-4-C-5032 for design/repair/renovation costs of the United Way building in Anchorage.
