All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

***1. Scope of Work***

The Denali Commission directs the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) to award \$470,190 to the Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments (CATG) for the redesign of a 15,673 square foot primary care subregional clinic in Fort Yukon, Alaska.

These funds shall be awarded to CATG from the pool of funds identified in "Table A" of the original award 0146-DC-2004-I29 as, "Construction funding for "non-specific" new or major renovation health projects."

The funds shall be passed through from the ANTHC to CATG per the September 2004 Memorandum of Understanding between the Denali Commission and the ANTHC, and as such will not include a project management fee.

The redesign shall be managed by CATG and redesign activities will be completed by the contractor CATG has previously procured through a competitive process. Funds provided by the Denali Commission shall be used to complete the redesign of the Fort Yukon primary care clinic and shall include 100% final design drawings, and a 100% construction cost estimate.

***2. Award Performance Period***

The Award performance period remains September 1, 2004 through September 30, 2006. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
