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***Award Conditions to the Financial Assistance Award
Between the Denali Commission and Valley Community for Recycling Solutions
For Solid Waste Equipment Purchase
Award No. 155-05, Amendment 1

All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

1. Scope of Work

This amendment awards an additional \$100,000 to the previous award in order to purchase a John Deere Model 304J loader and associated equipment. This will assist the Valley Community for Recycling Solutions in its efforts to manage regionally-collected materials for recycling. The process is more automated as a result of the horizontal baler and loading ramp purchased with the original Award 155-05. This regional nonprofit organization serves a number of small communities and makes it possible to pull recyclables from areas that would either landfill or randomly dispose of materials. Valley Community for Recycling Solutions will provide an additional In-Kind or Cash Match in the amount of \$4,000.

The title of this award is also amended to recognize this addition to the scope.

2. Award Performance Period

The amended Award performance period is February 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
