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RESOLUTION NO. 03-19 A RESOLUTION REGARDING FY03 INFRASTRUCTURE FUNDING FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA ALLIED HEALTH LEARNING CENTER

WHEREAS, the Denali Commission is investing in the development of health infrastructure across the State of Alaska, and

WHEREAS, the Denali Commission is committed to ensuring that facilities constructed for rural health care delivery are sustainable for the future, and

WHEREAS, a component of sustainable health facilities is the individuals working in the Allied Health Careers that support the delivery of health services from Commission invested facilities, and

WHEREAS, the University of Alaska has developed a proposal to expand the delivery of Allied Health Careers to rural Alaska residents, and

WHEREAS, the Denali Commission strongly supports this proposal and especially encourages the development of Allied Health Careers directly with the employers such as hospitals and regional health corporations, and

WHEREAS, the Denali Commission has identified that an appropriate role for the Commission at this time is in the development of University of Alaska infrastructure facilities that support the expansion of Allied Health Careers to rural Alaska, and

WHEREAS, Denali Commission funding for any project must demonstrate the full sustainability of the facility and operations consistent with the Denali Commission sustainability resolution, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Commission allocates up to \$1,000,000 in Fiscal Year 2003 infrastructure funding for the Allied Health Learning Center facility upgrades which includes the Community Health Aide Practitioners Facility which will be co-located.
