RESOLUTION NO. 04 – 13

YAKUTAT FUEL DOCK

WHEREAS, the United States Coast Guard has condemned the City and Borough of Yakutat's only fuel dock, but allowed limited use of the dock for bulk fuel delivery on a temporary basis under the condition that the owner show some realistic plans for the dock's replacement, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Yakutat has submitted a pre-application to the Economic Development Administration for construction funds for a replacement dock, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Yakutat has invested about \$50,000 in this project, with the authority to contribute additional support to the project through bonding, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Yakutat will continue its tariff on fuel passing over its dock and through its pipeline, yielding about \$40,000 per year to be available for on-going maintenance,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission allocate up to \$110,000 for project permitting as well as final engineering and design work for the City and Borough of Yakutat Dock Project.
