Alaska Clearinghouse

Since conception, the Clearinghouse has received roughly 140 inquiries and 20 meeting requests. Of these requests, 30 percent of these requests are for general information on stimulus funds/events and the remaining 70 percent are communities, tribes, Native corporations, non-profit organizations, small business owners and individuals sharing their economic distress status and desperate need to receive information on how to apply for the stimulus funding. Most requests for competitive grant information are from those who have never applied for federal funding.
