



A. INTRODUCTION

On May 22, 2008, the ANTHC and the Native Village of Akhiok executed a Cooperative Project Agreement (CPA) to construct a new health clinic in the Native Village of Akhiok, Alaska. The project scope includes site preparation, materials and equipment, construction, and labor.

This project is funded with \$1,479,086, via Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award 185-05 Amendment 8, dated May 2008. The original funding also included \$308,143 from the IHS FY08 and \$35,216 from KANA FY07.

The project has previously been amended as follows:

Amendment No. 1 to the CPA reprogrammed \$27,468 from the ANTHC support services direct charges scope item and added it to external construction management.
