**A. INTRODUCTION**

Throughout this Amendment these entities are referred to as follows:

City of Brevig Mission	=	City
Norton Sound Health Corporation	=	NSHC
Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium	=	ANTHC
Cooperative Project Agreement	=	CPA
Denali Commission	=	Commission

On April 17, 2006, ANTHC and Norton Sound Health Corporation executed a CPA authorized by the Denali Commission to perform the design and the construction planning for a new health clinic in Brevig Mission, Alaska. No construction was performed under this project phase.

The project was funded with \$99,345, via Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award No. 0146-DC-2004-I29, Addendum E, dated February 2006.

**B. REVISION OF PROJECT FUNDING**

This Amendment adds \$50,000 of City funds, which were provided via City of Brevig Mission 2006 Norton Sound Economic Development Corporation Community Benefit Shares.

Project funding therefore totals \$149,345.

By signing this Agreement, the City agrees 1) its matching funds shall be transferred to ANTHC within three days of receiving a valid invoice from DEHE, and 2) if these matching funds are not made available, project activities will be curtailed.

C. REVISION OF PROJECT ADMINISTRATION

This Amendment changes project administration to the following:

Design management shall be accomplished by ANTHC or its contractor. ANTHC shall take responsibility for all project oversight, technical assistance, and management of the design process. It is anticipated that ANTHC will use one of its indefinite quantity architect and engineering contractors to complete site adaptation of the NSHC prototype design for the provision of a primary care facility in Brevig Mission, Alaska.
