

A. INTRODUCTION

Throughout this Amendment these entities are referred to as follows:

Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium	=	ANTHC
Division of Environmental Health and Engineering	=	DEHE
Denali Commission	=	Commission

On October 14, 2008, ANTHC executed a Cooperative Planning Project Agreement (CPPA) for the completion of Code and Conditions surveys for the following community clinics and facilities: Allakaket; Coffman Cove; Hoonah; Larsen Bay; Karluk; Tatitlek; Iliuliuk Family and Health Services, Inc. in Unalaska; Wales; Whittier; Tideline Clinic in Wrangell; Wrangell Medical Center; and Ruby.

Funding for this project is made available to ANTHC through Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award 397-08 dated May 2008 and Project Authorization 00397-F, dated August 2008.

The project has previously been amended as follows:

Amendment No. 1 to the CPPA added an additional \$60,000, via Denali Commission Project Authorization 00397-H, dated January 2009, to the previous project funding amount of \$240,000, bringing the total project funding amount to \$300,000. The amendment removed the following community clinics and facilities: Iliuliuk Family and Health Services, Inc. in Unalaska, Tideline Clinic in Wrangell and the Wrangell Medical Center per Amendment 00397-F-01. The amendment also added clinics in Takotna, Ekwok, and Tanana per Amendment 00397-H.

TO: IHS NEPA Determination

Federal funding for this project requires an environmental review in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA). The Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) uses the Indian Health Service (IHS) environmental review procedures as outlined in the Environmental Review Manual, issued in January 2007. Current IHS policy (Federal Register, Vol. 58, No. 3, January 6, 1993, pp. 569-572) allows for categorical exclusion of actions and construction activity that do not have a significant impact on the environment.

The original scope of work for Project AN 08-GLO was to document and list upgrades and maintenance needs of existing health facilities around the State

ANTHC completed an environmental review recommending that Project No. AN 08-GLO receive a categorical exclusion (CATEX) from further environmental review on July 2, 2009. This amendment changes the amounts in the final funding and cost tables, and the environmental impacts reviewed are within the scope of the original document and consistent with current regulations. No additional environmental review is necessary at this time.

The ANTHC will revisit this environmental review to determine if potential environmental concerns have been addressed if the scope of work changes.
