A. INTRODUCTION

Throughout this amendment the following entities are referred to as follows:

Village of Levelock	=	Village
Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium	=	ANTHC
Division of Environmental Health and Engineering	=	DEHE
Denali Commission	=	Commission
Indian Health Service	=	IHS
Bristol Bay Economic Development Corporation	=	BBEDC

The ANTHC, DEHE, role is to provide lasting solutions to promote healthy communities.

On September 4, 2008, ANTHC and the Levelock Village Council executed a Cooperative Project Agreement (CPA) for the provision of a new health clinic in the Village of Levelock, Alaska.

The project was funded with \$1,413,425 from Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 397-08, dated May 2008 and subsequent Project Authorization dated May 20, 2008.

B. RECOMMENDED CHANGES

In order to complete the scope of this project, the following changes are necessary.

B 1. Changes in Funding
