The Alaska State Historic Preservation Office (AK SHPO) has reviewed the subject project (received December 23, 2011) pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. Following our review, we concur that a finding of **no historic properties affected** is appropriate for the subject project.

As a reminder, should inadvertent discoveries of cultural resources (historic, prehistoric, and archaeological sites, locations, remains, or objects) be encountered during the construction of the proposed landing ramp, the resources will need to be evaluated for eligibility for inclusion to the National Register of Historic Places (*36 CFR § 800.4*) and the nature of project effects on any eligible historic properties will need to be assessed (*36 CFR § 800.5*). Efforts to avoid, minimize or mitigate adverse effects to such properties will need to be resolved in consultation with our office (*36 CFR § 800.6*).
