

**A. INTRODUCTION**

Throughout this Amendment these entities are referred to as follows:

Denali Commission	=	Commission
Financial Assistance Sub-Award	=	FSA

On November 26, 2002, ANTHC and the Bridges Community Resource Network Inc. executed an FSA authorized by the Denali Commission to purchase dental equipment and make limited renovations to an existing health clinic or purchased facility space so that the dental equipment may be used. This project was funded by the Denali Commission.

**B. CHANGES**

Two parts constitute this Amendment:

- 1) Central Peninsula Health Centers, Inc. has replaced Bridges Community Resource Network, Inc. as the owner of the dental equipment, health clinic, or purchased facility space.
- 2) This project was originally awarded \$132,465. This Amendment adds \$4,913 of Commission funding for a total award of \$137,378. The additional funds will pay for medical equipment.

The additional funds are derived from Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 0100-DC-2003-I13, Addendum A, dated December 2003.
