Federal funding for this project requires an environmental review in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA). The Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) uses the Indian Health Service (IHS) environmental review procedures as outlined in the Environmental Review Manual, issued in January 2007. Current IHS policy (Federal Register, Vol. 58, No. 3, January 6, 1993, pp. 569-572) allows for categorical exclusion of actions and construction activity that do not have a significant impact on the environment.

The original scope of work for Project AN 11-GN7 was to complete the Code and Condition Survey of the Upper Tanana Health Center in Tok, Alaska. No construction was performed under this project phase.

This amendment changes the amounts in the final funding and cost tables. The environmental impacts reviewed are within the scope of the original document and consistent with current regulations. No additional environmental review is necessary at this time.
