Further, I hereby authorize the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, its agents, employees and contractors, on behalf of the Denali Commission, to enter upon portions of the Native Village of Tuntutuliak lands as shown in Exhibit A, to construct the **Tuntutuliak Moorings Point Project** as set forth in the plans and specifications held in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Alaska District.
