Between the Denali Commission and the Norton Sound Health Corporation (NSHC)

All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

1. Scope of Work

The Commission shall provide an additional \$100,000 for conceptual design of the proposed health clinics in Savoonga and Gambell. Previous work by NSHC and the respective communities identified a health delivery system that includes mid-level providers in both locations. Both the Commission and NSHC have come to recognize that the service delivery model and corresponding facility space program and layout is outside the Commissions prototype clinic design. Furthermore, both parties accept that some level of architectural and engineering analysis is necessary in order to define the necessary square footage of clinic and support space in both communities. Consequently, the additional funding is provided to identify this square footage and thus allowing the communities and NSHC to complete the clinic business plans.

All Commission funding is intended for use for the scope of work identified in the Award document only.

2. Award Performance Period

The award performance period is extended one year from August 1, 2002 through September 30, 2005. This is the period during which financial assistance award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
