RESOLUTION NO. 05-12

A RESOLUTION ON SOLID WASTE PROGRAM FOR FEDERAL FY 2005

WHEREAS Title VII Section 767 of the CONSOLIDATED APPROPRIATIONS ACT 2005 (H.R. 4818) appropriated through US Department of Agriculture - Rural Development to the Denali Commission to remain until expended, \$1,500,000 "*to address deficiencies in solid waste disposal sites which threaten to contaminate rural drinking water supplies*"; and

WHEREAS qualified communities in rural Alaska responded to the FY04 program as outlined in the Request For Proposals (RFP), and improvements are in progress across the state that will deliver examples of effective technology; and

WHEREAS solid waste management needs are wide-spread in rural Alaska;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission allocate \$1,413,600 to be awarded through a Request for Proposal (RFP). The objective is to assist communities in their management of solid waste in a manner that is locally appropriate and will improve both local and downstream impacts to drinking water supplies; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that up to \$100,000 of the \$1,413,600 is made available for evaluating state-wide solid waste management strategies in collaboration with Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium, and other involved organizations.
