RESOLUTION NO. 06-16

A RESOLUTION ON *PRIOR YEAR YOUTH PSYCHIATRIC FACILITY FUNDS*

WHEREAS the Denali Commission Act of 1998 was amended in 1999 to allow the Commission to plan, construct and equip health facility infrastructure for Alaska; and

WHEREAS the Denali Commission received congressional direction to fund statewide youth psychiatric facilities in FY05; and

WHEREAS the FY05 funding totaled \$4,150,000 and \$2,500,000 of that is available to statewide projects; and

WHEREAS the FY06 Health Facilities Funding Strategy funds \$3,000,000 through Resolution 06-15 to meet statewide needs making the total funding available to this program \$5,500,000; and

WHEREAS a prioritized project list in development, recommended by the Commission's Health Steering Committee for funding pending completion of due diligence; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Denali Commission authorizes the balance of FY05 youth psychiatric funds in the amount of \$2.5 million toward statewide youth psychiatric facilities identified in the prioritized strategy supported by the Health Steering Committee.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any funds allocated by this resolution which fail to proceed in a manner that will allow for full utilization of the funds within the timeframe established by HRSA, are to be reallocated to other prioritized health facility projects.
