## **RESOLUTION NO. 06-24**

### **A RESOLUTION ON DENALI COMMISSION TRAINING PROGRAM FOR FEDERAL FY 2006**

**WHEREAS** the Denali Commission is committed to training local residents for construction, operations and maintenance careers related to Denali Commission infrastructure investment in rural Alaska; and

**WHEREAS** the Denali Commission believes that local residents should receive training that leads to employment on Denali Commission-funded infrastructure projects; and

**WHEREAS** the Denali Commission believes that the sustainability of Commission-funded infrastructure is reliant on properly trained local residents; and

**WHEREAS** it is the intent of the Denali Commission to provide funding to training of rural residents for long term careers; and

**WHEREAS** the Denali Commission has a total of \$6,530,832 available for the Federal Fiscal Year 2006 Training Program from an appropriation through the U.S. Department of Labor; and

**WHEREAS** the Denali Commission has established partnerships with several organizations that will provide training related projects that meet the goals of the Denali Commission;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the Commission allocates up to \$6,530,832 in Fiscal Year 2006 funding provided by the U.S. Department of Labor for the Denali Commission Training Program for the following training projects:


1. \$250,000 to Associated General Contractors for NCCER Core Curriculum expansion and skill assessment on public infrastructure projects, as presented in the proposal submitted to the Denali Commission;

2. \$1,260,000 to the University of Alaska to enhance and expand allied health training programs for entry into Denali Commission-funded health facilities, as presented in the proposal submitted to the Denali Commission;  
Six Affirmative; Zero Opposed (Commissioner Hamilton abstained)

3. \$1,390,832 to the State of Alaska Department of Labor & Workforce Development to support the Denali Training Fund (DTF);  
Seven Affirmative; Zero Opposed
4. \$850,000 to the State of Alaska Department of Labor & Workforce Development for an RFP supporting the Denali Youth Initiative, High Growth Energy Industry Youth Strategies, and School-to-Apprenticeship Strategies;  
Seven Affirmative; Zero Opposed
5. \$300,000 to the State of Alaska Department of Labor & Workforce Development for management and oversight of the Denali Training Fund, Requests for Proposals and all Denali Commission-approved training projects;  
Seven Affirmative; Zero Opposed
6. \$230,000 to First Alaskans Institute to support the Alaska Native leadership initiative, as presented in the proposal submitted to the Denali Commission;  
Seven Affirmative; Zero Opposed
7. \$1,250,000 to Alaska Works Partnership for registered apprenticeship training on public infrastructure projects and expanding apprenticeship opportunities for rural Alaskans, as presented in the proposal submitted to the Denali Commission; and  
Seven Affirmative; Zero Opposed
8. \$1,000,000 to Cape Fox Heritage Foundation for the development of a pool of employees to work in a regional multi-use technology center, as presented in the proposal submitted to the Denali Commission.
