## RESOLUTION NO. 06-09

### A RESOLUTION ON ALASKA PUBLIC BROADCASTING INCORPORATED

**WHEREAS**, the Denali Commission Act of 1998 states that one of the areas of focus for the Denali Commission is telecommunications for rural Alaska; and

**WHEREAS**, the Congressional intent language in the Federal Fiscal Year 2006 (FY06) Energy and Water Appropriations directs continued funding for the revitalization and development of Alaska's public broadcasting infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alaska Public Broadcasting Incorporated (APBI) performed a statewide needs assessment which identified \$38 million in need for repair, renovation, new construction and technology and equipment upgrades to public broadcasting facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, APBI has developed a Request for Proposals process which incorporates the Commission's policies of Sustainability, Investment and Private Enterprise; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the Denali Commission allocates \$2.0 million in FY 06 funding to APBI for repair, renovation, new construction, and technology and equipment upgrades to public broadcasting facilities in rural Alaska pursuant to applicable Denali Commission Guiding Principles and Policies.
