Dear Denali Commission Grant Recipient,

I want to take this opportunity to introduce myself and the Office of Inspector General (OIG) to the funding recipients of the Denali Commission. OIG seeks to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of Commission programs and operations; detect and deter waste, fraud, and abuse; and monitor and track the use of taxpayer dollars through audits, inspections, evaluations, and investigations.

On May 28, 2014, the Denali Commission and the Department of Commerce Office of Inspector General entered into an agreement for the Department's OIG to provide a full range of oversight to the Commission. I have been appointed Acting Inspector General for the Denali Commission and will be devoted full time to that responsibility through at least calendar year 2015. As Acting Inspector General, I am responsible for keeping the commissioners and Congress fully and currently informed about problems and deficiencies relating to Commission activities, as well as the need for corrective action.

Please note that OIG does not have authority to investigate Equal Employment Opportunity complaints.

Regardless of the method you use to report allegations, OIG will not disclose your identity without your consent, unless the Inspector General determines such disclosure is unavoidable during the course of the investigation.
